Contest information

An original, referenced essay of a healthcare concept, policy or clinical issue focused on the oral health of older adults.

Who is eligible?

- Dental and dental hygiene students currently enrolled in accredited US or Canadian schools or programs.
- Up to 3 students may collaborate on one entry.

What is the format?

- Typewritten or word-processed (no smaller than 10 point type)
- 8-1/2" X 11" white paper, one side only
- Double-spaced, 1" margins
- Maximum of 2,000 words (excluding title page and bibliography/references)
- Title page to include: name(s) of author(s) year of graduation, institution name, address and telephone number of Dean's office
- References: format used in the Journal *Special Care in Dentistry*
- Submit via email or on disc in MS Word format

It is recommended that a faculty preceptor be involved in preparing this entry.

All essays will be submitted to the *Special Care in Dentistry* Journal for consideration of publication.

When is the deadline?

An original research project on a geriatric oral health issue, completed by the author.

Who is eligible?

- US or Canadian graduate students, residents and fellows in oral health

science AND those having completed a program within the past year.

- Up to 3 students may collaborate on one entry.

What is the format?

- Typewritten or word-processed (no smaller than 10 point type)
- 8-1/2" X 11" white paper, one side only
- Double-spaced, 1" margins
- Maximum of 2,000 words (excluding title page, bibliography/references and abstract)
- Title page to include: name(s) of author(s), year of graduation, institution name, address and telephone number of Dean's office
- Abstract: not to exceed 150 words
- Statement of role of author
- Introduction, Methods and Materials, Results and Discussion
- References: format used in the Journal *Special Care in Dentistry*
- Submit via email or on disc in MS Word format

All essays will be submitted to the *Special Care in Dentistry* Journal for consideration of publication.
